Cathedral yearbook recognized nationally for excellence

Cathedral High School publication one of only eight featured

INDIANAPOLIS—March 31, 2016— Tony Willis, Cathedral High School's yearbook and newspaper moderator announces today that Cathedral's yearbook, the Cathedran, is featured in a national publication, one of only eight high school yearbooks so recognized in the state of Indiana.

The cover and a photo from the 2015 Cathedran yearbook are featured in this year's edition of Ideas That Fly, a book published by Herff Jones that showcases the best middle school, high school and college yearbooks from across North America.

According to Bruce Hartley, the director of marketing for Herff Jones Yearbook Division, the 336-page book highlights top-notch coverage, design, themes and photography from 405 yearbooks in the United States and Canada. The Cathedran is one of eight high school yearbooks from Indiana included in the most recent book, the 21st edition.

Material from the 2015 Cathedran selected includes a photo from the Irish 500 as well as the yearbook's cover, which featured a cloth C similar what is sewn on a letter jacket.

According to Herff Jones representative Kim Minnich, this marks the first time the Cathedral yearbook has been included in Ideas That Fly, which thousands of yearbook staffs will use to generate ideas for their 2017 yearbooks and the volumes that follow.

Katherine Deighan '15 and Emma Vielee '15 served as the co-editors of the 2015 Cathedran yearbook.
