Cathedral class of 2016 earns record \$45.1 million in scholarships and awards

INDIANAPOLIS—May 23, 2016—Robert Bridges, Cathedral High School's new president, announced at commencement ceremonies yesterday that the Class of 2016 had earned the most scholarships and awards of any class in school history with \$44.9 million being offered. The scholarship amount is both the highest in terms of total dollars and also marks the highest ever per-student average of more close of \$139,000.

The Class of 2016 also set a school record with the greatest number of valedictorians with 15 seniors sharing the honors based on grade-point average, level of courses taken, length of time at Cathedral, and exemplary behavior both in and out of the classroom, says Principal Dave Worland. The class also boasts 20 merit scholars, four appointments to the military academies, and 44 student-athletes continuing onto the college level. In addition, seniors contributed 29,120 hours of service to the Indianapolis community during their four years at Cathedral.

Prestigious named scholarships earned by this year's seniors include Lilly Endowment Scholarship; Lilly Community, Scholarship, Wabash College; Adam W. Herbert Presidential Scholarship, Indiana University; two Kelley Scholarships at Indiana University; Cornelius Vanderbilt Scholarship, Vanderbilt University; two Ernie Pyle Scholarships, Indiana University; Center for Leadership Development Scholarship, Notre Dame; William R. Fry Scholarship, IU Kelley School of Business; Moreau Scholarship, St. Edward's University; Fund for Hoosier Excellence (Lugar Scholar); and the IHSAA C. Eugene Cato Memorial Scholarship.

The class has a 100 percent graduation rate and 100 percent were admitted to a four-year college or university.
