Two Cathedral seniors named IU Ernie Pyle Scholars

Williams and Wolff among select group accepted into IU Journalism's honors program

INDIANAPOLIS—March 4, 2016—Each year, the Media School at Indiana University chooses a select group of no more than 16 incoming freshmen from across the nation as Ernie Pyle Scholars.

This year, two of those students are Cathedral High School seniors.

Kara Williams and Emerson Wolff will begin their experience at Ernie Pyle Scholars next August at IU. As direct admit journalism majors, they will take classes with their fellow Scholars, be assigned a professor of practice to guide them through their undergraduate studies, participate in a media tour of Chicago, take part in seminars and programs at the Poynter Institute in St. Petersburg, Florida and spend the summer between their junior and senior years studying British media in London.

Both Williams and Wolff are three-year members of the Megaphone student newspaper at Cathedral. During their junior and senior years, they served as co-editors in chief, supervising a staff of 17 students who produce a 16- to 24-page paper every three to four weeks.

This is the second consecutive year a Cathedral senior has been named an Ernie Pyle Scholar. Annie Browning '15 is a freshman at IU and is in her second semester in the program.
