Is there Volunteer training? Volunteers are asked to attend an event orientation to review responsibilities. Orientations are offered October 6 at 6pm or October 10 at 10am.

Zoo Boo Volunteer Opportunities (1:30-7pm)

- 🍎 **Hay Bale Maze** - Help small children find their way through the straw maze
- 🍎 **Pumpkin Bowling** - Set up pins, hand out plastic pumpkins and monitor three lanes of bowling for children
- 🍎 **Bounce House** - Limit the time children are in the house, and try to separate younger and older children who want to bounce
- 🍎 **Greeter** - Welcome guests to the event and promote daily activities
- 🍎 **Touch Boxes Assistant** - Help guide visitors through activities. "Can you guess what's in the box?!"
- 🍎 **Hand out Candy** - Limited positions! Hand out candy to children. Must be fast, courteous and subject to repetitive motions.
- 🍎 **Mascots and Guides** - (1:30-5pm) Entertain guests and highlight activities throughout the event. (Volunteers need to attend a Mascot and Guide training before scheduling for this assignment.)

Floaters (4-7pm)

Volunteers will arrive in the middle of the event to provide breaks to other volunteers. Floaters may work in any of the above assignments (except for Mascots and Guides). A willingness to rotate throughout the Zoo and help where needed most is essential for this assignment!
